


## Wiki For Students

### How to Create a Wiki Page :

1. On the Wikis listing page, select a **Wiki title**
2. Select **Create Wiki Page**
3. Type the **Name** and **Content** in the Content text box
4. Click **Submit**

### Wiki Topic Page:

1. **Create a Wiki Page:** You can create as many wiki entries as you want.
2. **Wiki Instructions:** Expand the section to review the wiki instructions.
3. **Home Page :** The Home page for the wiki provides students with a starting point that they can edit or link additional pages to.
4. **Comment:** Select to add your thoughts.
5. **Wiki Details:** Expand the section to display information such as the type, creation date, and number of pages and comments.
6. **Wiki Pages:** Wiki pages appear in alphabetical order after the home page. The home page always appears first in the list. Access its menu to view the page history.
7. **My Contribution:** On this page, you can view information about your contribution to the wiki in the content frame and the side panel.

1. **Display Pages:** Use the Display Pages list to narrow what appears on the My Contribution page.
2. **Page Version:** In the Page Version column, page titles appear with their corresponding version numbers. Select a title to view the page without annotated changes. The page opens in a new window. By default, the most recent page version is listed first.
3. **Grade:** This section appears if your instructor enabled grading for the wiki. You can see if your wiki pages have been graded.
